LOCATION:

The Eastern Suffolk BOCES Summer Enrichment Program at Bay Shore will be housed at the Mary G. Clarkson School.

PROGRAM CONTENTS:

The Eastern Suffolk BOCES Summer Enrichment program is being offered for students who have completed any grade from Kindergarten through Grade 5. The program will begin with breakfast from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Instruction begins promptly at 8:30 a.m. and continues until 12 noon.

Two days a week, students will be bused to the YMCA Program at the ACLD Children's Center on Greenwood Road for an afternoon program conducted by YMCA recreation specialists. **Swimming instruction will be provided** to students in grades 1-3 and a supervised swim program with **basic rescue technique** instruction will be provided to students in grades 4-6. Other activities will include rock climbing, martial arts, team and individual sports, and arts and crafts. All students will be bused back to Mary G. Clarkson School. On days the students remain at Mary G. Clarkson School, the afternoon program will consist of team sports, art expressions, classroom activities, and individual games.

An optional after-care session will be available from 4:00 p.m. until 5:30 p.m.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES:

Science and Math Enrichment Courses

Hands-on science and math classes are designed to make ALL students get excited about the world around them. Sample programs include: Bubbles, Legoland, Robotics, Rocketry, Ornithology (Birds) and Whacky Science.

Literacy Courses

Students will participate in small groups specifically designed to develop literacy skills and engage students in their learning. Students should have fun as they design and author their own creative works. Sample programs include: Web Design, Cook Up A Story, Colonial Games, Viva Espanol, International Cooking and Chef Shop.

Reading Adventures - Reading for All

Students will explore a wide variety of texts by participating in small reading groups at their instructional levels and will become involved in activities related to their reading. Reading Adventures will use fiction and non-fiction to engage students as they learn how reading can expand their world.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- ✓ Parents will provide transportation to and from the program.
- ✓ There will be two sessions lasting three weeks each.
